How to get to Theatr Clwyd

By Rail:

Chester railway station is about 11 miles and Flint railway station 5 miles from Theatr Clwyd. Taxis are available at either, but it is advised that you pre-book taxis from Flint Station to Theatr Clwyd. The average cost of a taxi from Flint station is £12 and is £24 from Chester station. There are frequent trains from London Euston, some are direct but many change at Crewe. The quickest route to the theatre from London Euston (2hrs 35) is to change at Crewe and then get off at Flint. By Car:

You will find directions to Theatr Clwyd on Google Maps: <http://bit.ly/qDCVkm>. Click on 'Get Directions' (top-left sidebar) from anywhere in the UK. If you are travelling from London, you need to account for the M6 toll.

Car Parking

There is car parking across the road from the front of the theatre. You are required to Pay and Display between 8am and 5pm Monday to Saturday at a reasonable daily cost (currently 50p for 1 hour and £1.50 for the day). **Please note as of April 2021 due to COVID-19 restrictions, car parking is currently on the outdoor tiered car park opposite the theatre and there are no parking charges.** Please do not park at the back or side of the building. Please observe the restricted parking arrangements. There is regular enforcement and the fine is £70.

Buses to Mold from Flint & Chester

There's a bus stop outside the theatre, and buses run every 30 minutes from Flint and approximately every 2 hours from Chester. There are frequent buses from Mold town centre. When you arrive

Visiting Company Managers

Come to Reception and ask for the Duty Manager who will introduce you to the Duty Technician who will give all necessary assistance, including lanyards to be worn backstage in the Theatre.

Company Members

Company Members should also come to Reception (NOT the Stage Door, which is unstaffed), where they will be directed backstage. Your Company Manager will have lanyards to be worn backstage and parking permits. Keep these with you during your time at Theatr Clwyd and return them when you leave. There will be a charge for any unreturned lanyards and parking permits.

Dressing Rooms and Security

We cannot be responsible for the security of any personal belongings, unless held by Theatr Clwyd staff for safe keeping. You are advised to keep your dressing room locked at all times. If you are issued with a dressing room key, return it to your Company Manager at the end of every day. Please vacate dressing rooms and backstage areas within 30 minutes of the end of the performance. You may leave the theatre through Front of House after this time, but you will not be able to return backstage, so please make sure you have all your belongings with you.

A brief description of the layout of the theatre

As you come through the main doors you will reach reception. On the left and through the double doors are stairs leading to the first floor (there is also a lift near the stairs to the first and second floor). On the first floor, you will find the gallery space and café as well as entrances to the Emlyn Williams Theatre and Anthony Hopkins Theatre. On the second floor is the green room where you will be able to find a fridge to store any food, two microwaves and a seating area. To the left of the stairs as you reach the second floor, you will find the admin offices. The rehearsal room can be found by walking through the corridor, past the admin offices and to the end of the hallway.

Pets and Animals

No animals (apart from Guide Dogs) are permitted on the premises.

Smoking

Theatr Clwyd is a non-smoking venue. The policy applies to the entire building complex. In all public places in Wales, smoking is against law at any time, including outside the building, except in two clearly designated smoking areas. We have a zero-tolerance policy for smoking, drinking and substance abuse at Theatr Clwyd.

Redirecting post to Theatr Clwyd

Please make sure that any post arrives in good time for you to collect it by the end of your stay here. Make sure that anyone who writes to you uses your full name, the name of the production you're working on, and addresses it to: **Theatr Clwyd, Mold, CH7 1YA**. Your post will arrive in the pigeonholes in the Admin corridor – ask a member of the TC company to show you where they are. For those working on Theatr Clwyd productions, mail will be put in the Stage Management pigeonhole in the Admin Corridor, while Visiting Companies have a separate pigeonhole. TC Stage Management, and/or Visiting Company Stage Managers should check the pigeonholes once a day. If post arrives for you after you have left, we will try to make contact to let you know and we are happy to forward it on to you as long as you agree to pay for the postage. Our box office team will help you with this.

Phone calls to Theatr Clwyd

Although company phones are not provided for private use, ask your Company Manager if you need to use a private phone.

Photocopying

TC and Visiting Company members may use the photocopier on the Administration corridor, by arrangement with the Operations Manager (extension 1554) who will give you the code. There will be a charge for this service.
